- •Smoking and pets are not permitted anywhere on the farm.
- •Due to limited parking, please use the parking area in front of the barn. (if gate is closed, enter and close behind you)
- •Please do not feed or pet the alpaca without Island Alpaca staff supervision.
- •Please do not stand/climb on fencing. Closed-toed shoes are required at all times.
